Note: Tuition fees for Grade 10 and DP2 are payable in two terms and charges for the final external exams will be invoiced separately.

In addition to tuition fees, **an annual maintenance** cost of USD 300 will be charged along with the first-term tuition fees. This fee is payable once per academic year.

Parents of new students enrolling at the Aga Khan Education Service (AKES), Tanzania must pay a one-time admission fee of USD 500 and a refundable caution deposit of USD 200. The caution deposit will be refunded when the student leaves the school, provided all outstanding fees, including any fines, have been settled.

The amount stated above is in USD; however, fees can be paid in Tanzanian Shillings. Please contact the finance department for the applicable exchange rate.

The school promotes a shared learning environment for siblings and offers a 5% discount on annual tuition fees for the second child and beyond.

AKES, Tanzania does not accept cash payments. Please use bank deposits, mobile money or the Duka Direct app for payments. Parents can also visit the school to pay by card using Point of Sale (POS) machines available at the reception and finance office.

Please include the student identity number provided by the school in all payments to ensure the funds are correctly credited to the student's account.

Refunds:

Students who are registered and have paid fees for the current academic year but choose not to attend must provide written notice to AKES, Tanzania at least one term in advance to be eligible for a tuition refund. Refunds apply only to tuition fees and will be issued via cheque or bank transfer, with any transfer costs borne by the recipient.

Fees for the current term are non-refundable if a student withdraws after the term has begun. To withdraw from the following term, written notice must be submitted at least four calendar weeks before the current term ends. Failure to provide timely notice will result in tuition fees for the next term being non-refundable.
