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## Overview

The Aga Khan Mzizima Secondary School, Dar es Salaam is a private, non-profit, non-denominational, co-educational, day school for students in Grades 7-13. It is part of the Aga Khan Education Services (AKES), one of the largest pre-tertiary education networks across East Africa, the Middle East and South and Central Asia, with a vast majority of its schools located in rural and remote communities where access to quality education is limited. AKES is part of the Aga Khan Schools (AKS), an agency within the Aga Khan Development Network. AKS comprises a network of 200 schools, more than 100 non-formal education programme centres and eight hostels, serving almost 110,000 students from the age of 18 months to adulthood each year across 12 countries.

Established in 1905, AKES is built on over a century of leadership in education, equipping learners with the knowledge, skills, attitudes and values to thrive in a complex and dynamic world. The Aga Khan Mzizima Secondary School, Dar es Salaam contributes to this legacy by providing quality education for its students, along with opportunities for growth inside and outside the classroom.

## Curriculum

The Aga Khan Mzizima Secondary School, Dar es Salaam is an IB World School offering the Diploma Programme (DP). The International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE) and the National Examinations Council of Tanzania (NECTA), or national curriculum, are also available for students.

## Graduation requirements

- 6 subjects: 3 at Higher Level (HL) and 3 at Standard Level (SL)
- Theory of knowledge (TOK)
- 4,000-word extended essay (EE) on a student-chosen topic
- Creativity, activity, service (CAS): Extensive participation in community-based service projects

## Unique service initiatives

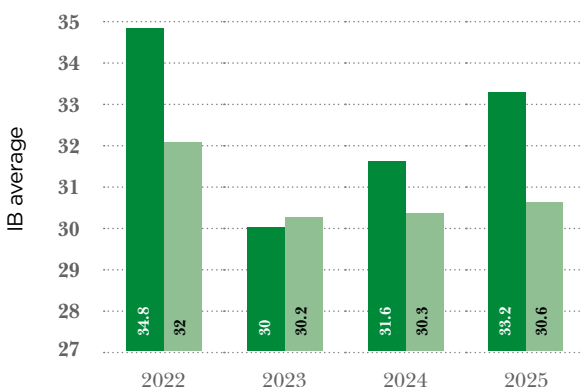
At the Aga Khan Mzizima Secondary School, Dar es Salaam, IB DP students collaborate with local organisations on a variety of initiatives for their CAS portfolio, which helps them develop their leadership and interpersonal skills. In 2025, the students embarked on a four-day service trip to Morogoro and Mikumi to promote environmental conservation. In Morogoro, they planted 100 clove and cinnamon trees with students from a local school and community members. In Mikumi, they collaborated with residents on strategies to reduce human-wildlife conflicts while safeguarding animals.

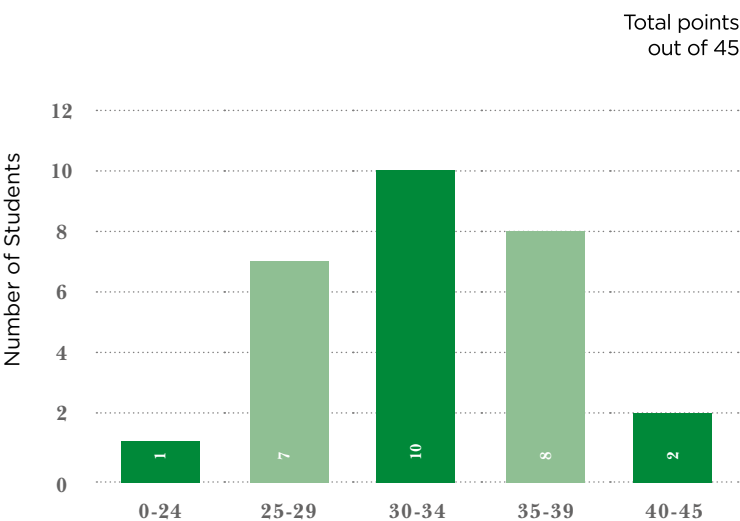
